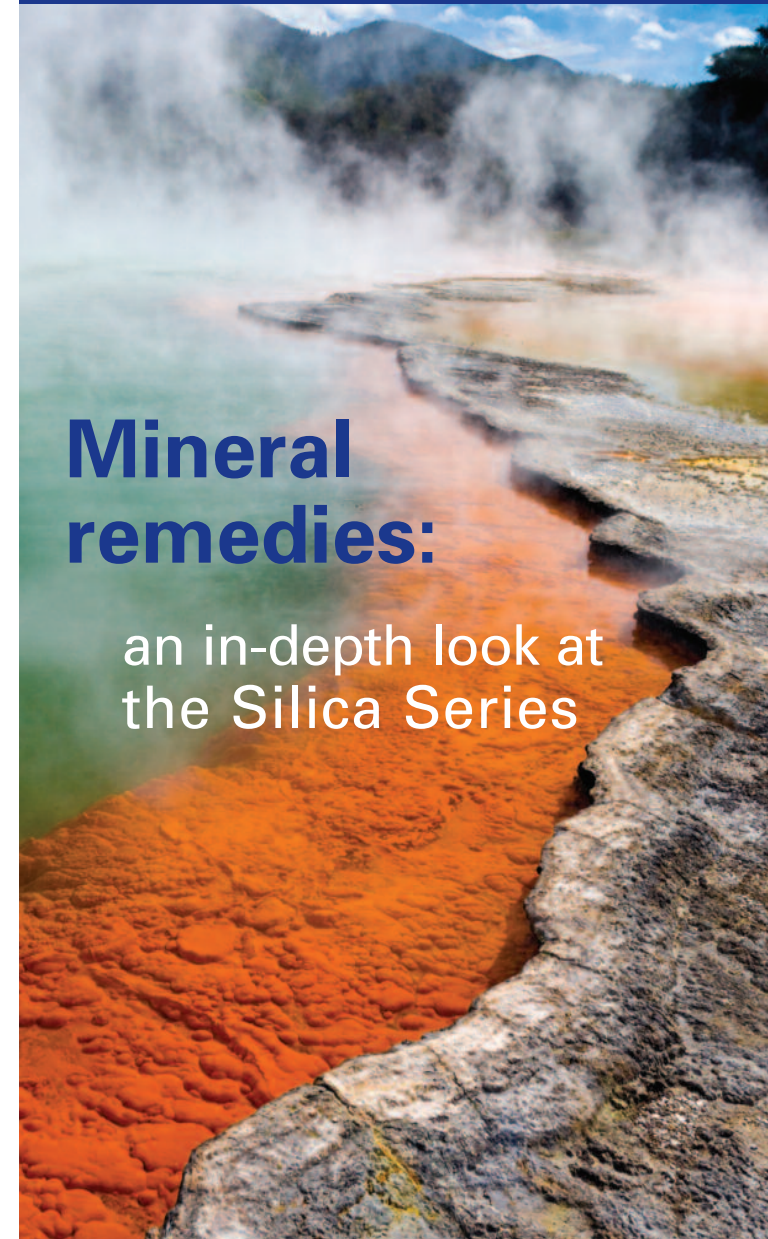

Currently she works one day a week at Bristol Homeopathic Hospital, and has a busy private practice in the city. Julie teaches widely in the UK and Europe and last October taught for the first time in Japan. Her own study of homeopathy never ends with her main teaching and inspiration coming from the Bombay School.
